

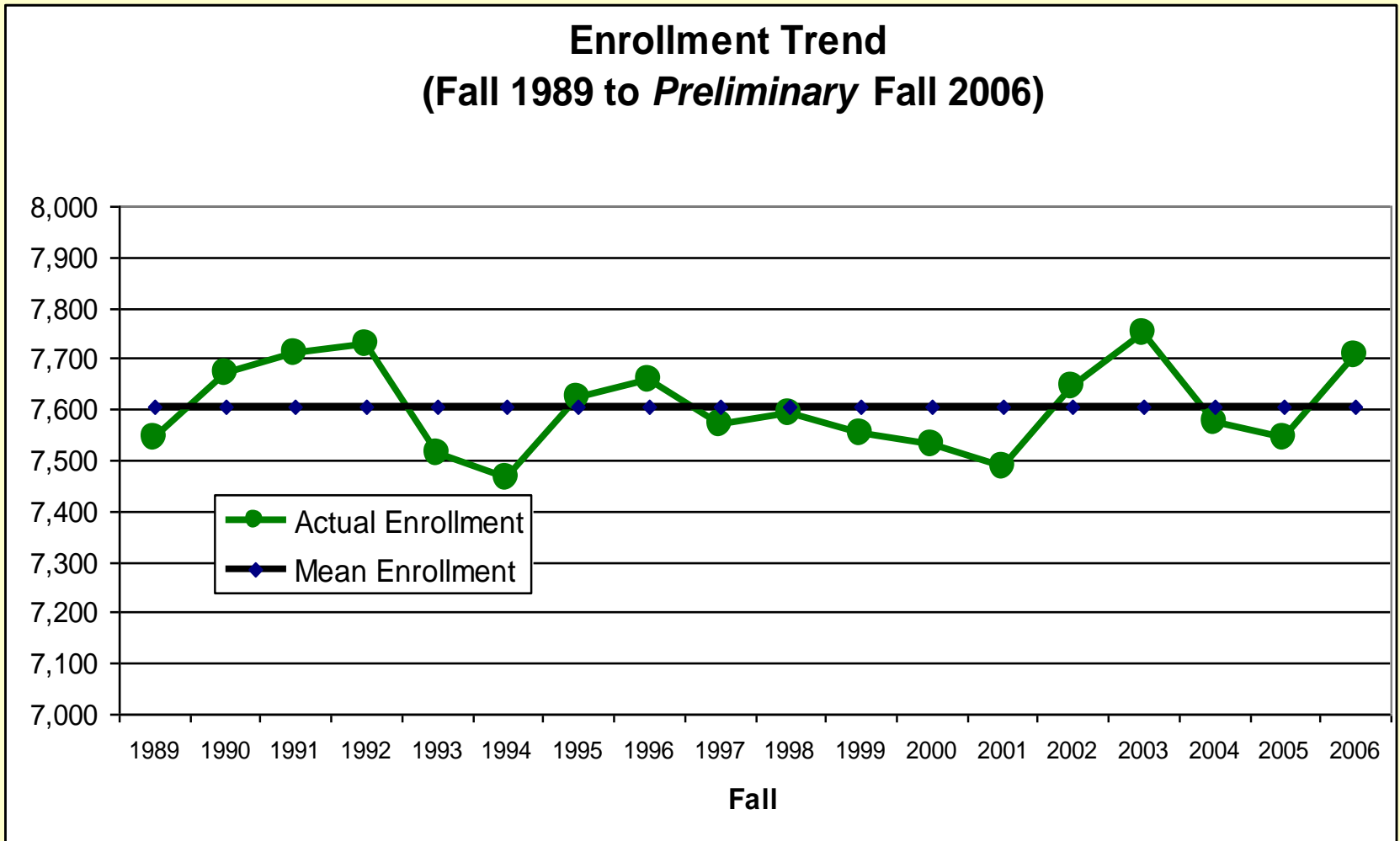

Fall Headcount Enrollment Trend





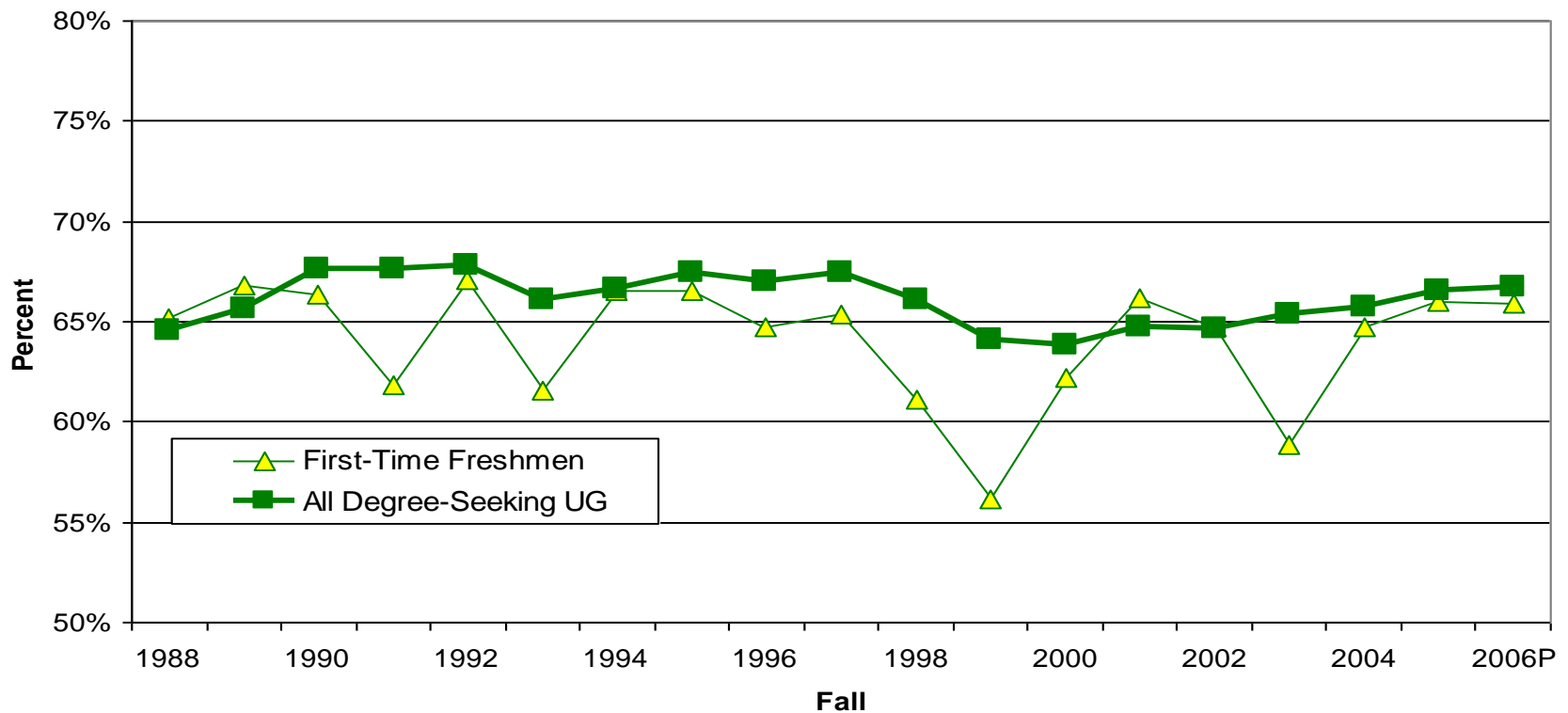
