

## PARKING AND GETTING AROUND CAMPUS

### GENERAL PARKING

Allow plenty of time for parking, especially on Sunday! Starting on Commencement Friday, families and guests may park in any space on campus marked Faculty/Staff, Resident Student, or Day Student. Parking is never permitted in the following areas: Fire lanes; No Parking zones; the Jones Hall lot; handicapped spaces (without a state-issued permit); "Reserved for" spaces; meters at the Muscarelle Museum; "Official Vehicle" spaces; or Service/Vendor spaces. These regulations are enforced 7 days/week, 24 hours/day. Visitors are expected to pay attention to all temporary signs related to parking restrictions on campus.

### OFF-CAMPUS PARKING (including Richmond Road)

Please be aware that streets surrounding the campus are controlled by the City of Williamsburg at all times. Parking in residential areas is enforced using color-coded decals. Do not park on streets that require a resident decal. Visitors should pay attention to all signs related to parking restrictions on city streets.

### HANDICAPPED PARKING

Handicapped plates and hangtags from any state are valid for the purpose of parking in handicapped-designated spaces on campus. Accessible parking can be found in various locations and is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Most lots on campus have some designated handicapped parking spaces. The Walk Across Campus will block traffic on Ukrop Way beginning around 10:45 a.m. on Sunday. Plan to arrive at W&M Hall and find parking no later than 10:45 a.m. to avoid delays. Once the lots around W&M Hall are full, cars will be directed to the parking deck on Ukrop Way, near Miller and Adair Halls (approximately a 10-minute walk from W&M Hall).

The College does not provide bus or shuttle service between the main ceremony and departmental events. The Commencement Committee has scheduled enough time between events for guests to make their way from W&M Hall to the various ceremony locations.
