To remain eligible for guaranteed admission, I must enter W&M within three years following graduation from RBC. If I have not met the requirements outlined in the articulation agreement, I may apply for admission through the normal application process.

By signing this form, I certify that the above information is truthful. I also give permission to both W&M and RBC to release information to one another concerning my academic performance, as well as to report any violations of judicial and honor regulations.
