Every year the Department of Classical Studies has money available through the Hogan Fund to support students. In the past we have helped to fund participation in excavations and overseas programs, as well as to offer scholarship stipends for activities such as attending a summer Latin Institute.

If you are interested in applying for these funds, here are the steps you need to follow:

- 1) Meet with your advisor or another faculty member in the Department. This will give you the opportunity to discuss your proposal and to ensure that it falls within the parameters of the Hogan Fund.
- 2) Submit a short proposal describing your project. Please include with your proposal a brief budget outlining how much money you need and how you plan to spend it.
- 3) Make sure that we receive your request by 16 March 2009.
