#### **Summary**


In the 2016-17 school year, the CAS committee reviewed 802 CAS petitions. CAS petitions included requests for the following actions:

- Appeal of a previous CAS decision
- Late Add
- Late Drop
- Late Withdrawal
- Medical underload (i.e. requesting to take less than 12 credits because of a medical purpose)
- Other, which included comments on the action
- Overload (i.e. requesting to take more than 19 credit hours)
- Partial Medical Withdrawal (i.e. withdrawal from certain but not all courses due to a medical purpose)
- Reinstatement to good standing
- Underload (i.e. requesting to take less than 12 credits).

The committee also reviewed 461 MRC petitions. In total, the committee reviewed 1,263 petitions from students this year. MRC petitions included requests for:

- Full withdrawal
- Partial Withdrawal
- Medical Clearance
- Partial Withdrawal to Underload
- Medical Clearance and Re-enrollment
- Retroactive Medical Withdrawal.


# **Overall CAS Outcomes**

Of the 802 CAS petitions reviewed by the committee, 578 were approved, 147 were denied, and 77 were cancelled.



Of the 461 MRC petitions this year, 408 (88.5%) of them were approved, 40 (8.67%) were denied, 8 (1.74%) requested additional information, and 5 (1.09%) were deferred to CAS for decision with recommendation by MRC. These numbers are consistent with the increase in care reports.




Of the 802 petitions reviewed by the CAS committee, the most common petition was Overload with 250 petitions. The next most common were petitions that requested multiple actions, which could be any combination of actions, with 174 petitions. The third most common were petitions for Late Add.

Of the 461 MRC petitions, 98 (21.26%) were for Full Medical Withdrawals, 5 (1.08%) were for Medical Clearance, 101 (21.9%) were for Medical Clearance and Re-enrollment, 66 (14.32%) were for Partial Withdrawal, 153 (33.19%) were for Partial Medical Withdrawal to Underload, and 38 (8.25%) were for Retroactive Medical Withdrawal.

The most commonly requested action in CAS petitions was to overload credits. Of the 294 requests, 189 were approved. The second most commonly requested action was to Late Add a class. Of the 250 requests, 211 were approved. The third most common was to Late Withdrawal from a class. Of the 152 requests, 110 were approved.

The other most requested actions in order of frequency are: underload (117); late drop (98); appeal of a previous CAS decision (27); reinstatement to good standing (22); other (see comments) (21); medical underload (5); and partial medical withdrawal (3).
