ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY- 1992-1993

I. SEMESTER RESEARCH ASSIGNMENTS

The committee received 36 applications for semester research assignments and recommended funding for 30 (the same number as last year). The provost approved funding for 29, all those with at least 6 years of service and recommended by the committee. Funding for those with less than six years of service is rare. See Appendix A for the list of those receiving funding.

II. SUMMER RESEARCH ASSIGNMENTS

Eighty-nine members of the faculty applied for Summer Research Grants (eleven more than last year). We recommended 62 for funding as excellent (eight more than last year), all of which were approved by the Provost. Of the remaining 27 applications, one was withdrawn, 20 were judged fundable but not excellent, one was judged unfundable, and 5 were from applicants who had received two Summer Grants in the last three years. See Appendix B for the list of those approved for funding.

III. MINOR RESEARCH GRANTS

A total of \$15,500 was budgeted for minor grants for the current academic year. Last year, the FRC did not distribute all the funds for minor grants due to a decline in applications. Anticipating the possibility of a similar result this year, the committee distributed approximately \$12,500 of the funds in the Fall semester. Unfortunately, there was a large number of applications in the Spring. Thus funds for the Spring were more limited than in the Fall, resulting in a smaller average distribution for the Spring than the Fall.

Also, there is apparently some problem with applicants receiving notification of the awards due to coordination problems between the Committee, the Planning Office, the Chairs of Departments, and the applicants. I am told that this is a problem with some history. Next year, the application will include a form for notification that can be mailed back directly to the applicant. See Appendix C for the list of funding for minor grants.

IV. BOOK SUBVENTIONS

The Committee approved two book subvention requests for \$2,000 each: Michael Faia's (Sociology) request regarding his book, Androgynous Sociology, and William Defotis's (Music) production of a CD entitled "Satire is Serious Business."

V. NEH SUMMER STIPENDS

The Committee received four applications for the nominations for the NEH Summer Stipends and nominated those of Maryann Brink, Monica Potkay, and Talbot Taylor. Potkay and Taylor went on to receive the awards by NEH.

VI. PENDING BUSINESS

There are two major items of business pending before the Committee. The first concerns an ongoing problem with getting people to serve on the Committee since doing so often costs faculty members opportunity for funding for their own research projects. The matter is now before the Faculty Assembly. The second item concerns a code for the behavior of members of the Committee and the confidentiality of the Committee's deliberations. The Committee will meet soon to discuss this matter.
