Dissertation Prospectus Colloquium

Instructions for writing a dissertation prospectus are in Appendix V of the Graduate Regulations. Rules governing the timing of the colloquia are in the graduate regulations. The student should complete the top of the form and print or type the committee members' names on the form before the colloquium. Committee members sign the form after the student successfully defends the prospectus. This may be at the colloquium or later, if significant changes need to be made. The advisor should then submit the completed form and a copy of the prospectus to the Director of Graduate Studies.
