

Home Visiting Nurses

Children’s Health Involving Parents (CHIP) is a program that works alongside parents to make sure children are healthy. CHIP provides support and access to healthcare services in the comfort of your home with their teams of nurses, mental health clinicians, and outreach workers. The team visits a family at least twice a month. They can visit more or fewer times a month depending on the family. Services are available from pregnancy until the child reaches age 6.

Sentara Home Care provides prenatal education and support from your home by providing:

- Access to classes to prepare for labor and delivery, parenting and nutrition and smoking cessation, as well as substance abuse counseling.
- Access to car seats and layettes
- Help obtaining WIC, Medicaid, and infant Social Security numbers
- Breastfeeding education and support
- Grief counseling
- Help finding a pediatrician, maintaining well-baby checkups and immunizations
- Nutritional counseling
- Referrals to community resources
