



PSYCHOLOGY MINOR REQUIREMENTS LISTED BY YEAR IN WHICH THE MINOR WAS DECLARED

Requirements for the Psychology Minor are determined by the course catalog that was in effect at the time you formally submitted your paperwork for declaration of the Minor. Minor requirements

- total Psychology credit hours = 21
- prerequisite courses: PSYC 201, 202
- any two courses from among courses numbered 370 to 390 and/or 450 to 470
- when to declare: after taking the necessary courses, students may declare a psychology minor in their senior year when they declare their intent to graduate; although, the student can declare their minor earlier if that is desirable

Major requirements

- total Psychology credit hours = 21
- prerequisite courses: PSYC 201, 202
- two elective even numbered courses from among PSYC 310-330 (social science requirement)
- two elective odd numbered courses from among PSYC 310-330 (natural science requirement)
- one elective course numbered PSYC 350-480 that can be either odd numbered or even numbered (depth requirement)
- when to declare: after taking the necessary courses, students may declare a psychology minor in their senior year when they declare their intent to graduate; although, the student can declare their minor earlier if that is desirable
