

Dear Majors,

Beginning this semester, the Psychology major requirements have changed.

The details are outlined in the latest course catalog (2008-2009).

In brief, we have increased the overall credit requirement to 35, which translates to 6 electives.

There are restrictions on the 6 electives: two must be even numbered and between 310 and 350, two must be odd numbered and between 310 and 350, and two must be upper level (350 or above).

The 201-202 sequence, 301-302 sequence, and the advanced research course are all still required.

**These new requirements will only apply to students declaring a Psychology major this semester (AU08) or later.**

Those of you who declared a Psychology major prior to this semester will follow the old restrictions: 32 total credits comprised of 201-202, 301-302, advanced research, and 5 electives.
