## INTENT

To provide scholarship support for academically distinguished students with financial need in the Theatre Program of the Department of Theatre, Speech & Dance.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants must be undergraduates of rising senior class status or below as award is applied toward tuition and fees for the following academic year.

Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 overall grade point average.

# **GRANT, NOT A LOAN**

The Lang Legacy Award is a grant, not a loan.

## **PRIORITIES OF RECIPIENTS**

The Lang Award will be awarded according to the following priorities.

## First priority will be given to:

Full-time rising junior or rising senior theatre majors for whom financial assistance will be significant for studies at William & Mary during the regular academic year.

# Second priority will be given to:

Full-time rising junior or rising senior non-majors who are clearly committed to theatre studies for whom financial assistance will be significant for studies at William & Mary during the regular academic year.

#### **APPLICATION**

Interested individuals must submit the application form and all supporting documentation through the link posted on the TSD Scholarships and Awards webpage by the posted deadline.

#### RECIPIENT SELECTION

Approval of the Theatre Scholarship recipient requires a majority vote of all full-time theatre faculty and staff. The Scholarship may be awarded to one or more individuals
