

Computer Proficiency Requirement

The Computer Proficiency Requirement (CPR) in International Relations should be filed with the International Relations Program before your senior year and in no case later than the beginning of the final semester before graduation.

IR majors may satisfy the computer proficiency requirement in one of two ways:

1. By completing **Computer Science 131** or higher; or
2. By fulfilling the computing requirement for a department that offers courses in your particular major. The following is a list of departments and courses that meet the requirements. Please check each department's website for the most up-to-date list of courses satisfying the CPR.

Business	Buad 231, 330
Economics	Econ 307, 308
Government	Lab (L) sections of Govt: 201L, 203L, 204L or 301, 307, 465
History	Hist 212-06, 330-01, 386-01, 418-01, 491-05 (Subject to change each semester. Courses that meet the CPR are indicated as such in the "attributes" column on Banner.)
Sociology	Socl 353 or an approved equivalent statistics course
