The salary cap for eligibility for recertification is \$53,000 for the second year of LRAP assistance and \$56,000 for the third year. A material change in a current recipient's financial or employment circumstances – or, if applicable – his/her spouse's employment or financial circumstances, requires filing a new application, not this recertification form.¹

¹ In September 2007, the federal College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007 was enacted. That legislation provides expanded loan repayment assistance for graduates in qualifying public service employment. Public service employment under the new federal law is not limited to federal government work. The CCRAA also creates income-based loan repayment for "high debt/low income" borrowers, even if they are not in public service employment.
