DC Semester ProgramProgram Costs

Tuition:

Students enrolled in the DC Semester Program pay standard semester tuition and fees (for either In-State or Out-of-State: seen at www.wm.edu/offices/financialoperations/sa/tuition/index.php) directly to the College. Tuition is charged to the student's account and is payable either via check or online via eServices.

Program Fee:

The DC Semester Program fee is \$500.00. This fee covers costs for programming and events while the students are in Washington. Examples from past semesters include: Orientation week, group dinners, receptions, special tours, outings to museums or theatres, and activities such as bowling and kayaking.

Housing Cost:

The rate for a double room is \$5,000 or \$7,700 for a single room. All students live in either a two-bedroom or three-bedroom apartment at 450K in the heart of DC, and just three short Metro stops from the W&M Washington Center. Each apartment is fully furnished and features two bathrooms, plus an equipped kitchen, a dining room, a living room, and a balcony, and a washer/dryer in each unit. 450K also provides a fitness center, media room, rooftop with Washington Monument Views, bike storage, and an outdoor lap pool. There is no housing application fee or security deposit.

<u>Additional Expenses</u>:

The average cost per student varies; however, most students report spending between \$125 - \$175 per week (for 16 weeks) on groceries, metro, and other personal expenses (including toiletries, entertainment and cultural events, social events, and travel beyond DC).
