

Information about Displaying a Handicapped Parking Pass

This pass is temporary. It has been provided as a courtesy to you alone and is for use in designated parking areas on the campus of the College of William and Mary only.

Display this pass properly and make sure that it is valid. Tape this pass in the rear window, driver's side, facing outward. This pass is valid only when your car also displays a current William and Mary parking decal which may be purchased in the Parking Services Office, 204 S. Boundary Street. The Parking Services Office is not accessible to patrons with physical limitations; if you have a physical limitation and wish to purchase a decal, you may contact the Parking Services Office at 221-4764 to make alternative purchase arrangements.

This pass permits parking in any handicapped, faculty/staff, day, resident, or metered space in descending order according to availability. When metered spaces are the only parking option, you may utilize these spaces without feeding the meter.

This pass does not permit parking in service vehicle spaces, reserved towing enforced spaces, Visitors of the President spaces, fire lanes, and no parking zones. If you do so, expect to be ticketed.

If you require a time extension of this issued handicapped parking pass, please have your physician write or fax the request outlining the proposed range of extension, the reason for extension, and prognosis of injury. The College of William and Mary cannot issue handicapped parking passes beyond one full semester or 15 weeks. Students who anticipate requiring this level of support should work jointly with their physicians and the Department of Motor Vehicles.
