

Plumeri Award for Athletics Leadership Excellence Selection and Announcement Process

The Plumeri Awards recognize and reward outstanding coaches and staff whose core virtues and accomplishments help to define excellence in intercollegiate athletics at William & Mary.

Award nominees will be evaluated on their accomplishments and contributions to student-athlete and/or departmental success in a variety of areas. Evidence of excellence in these areas may include athletic performance, academic achievement, professional recognition, and/or service to the community or organization. The Plumeri Award celebrates passion, vision, and leadership; successful applicants will be engaged citizens of the university community and dedicated stewards of our core values.

Selection

A committee will review completed applications and recommend the strongest candidates as finalists to the Provost. Interviews will be conducted with finalists to assist the Provost in making the ultimate selection.

One awardee will be selected every year and will receive a \$20,000 prize expendable over a three-year period. Individuals may be selected for the award multiple times, but only once in a five-year period.

Application Process

To be considered for this prestigious honor, full-time coaches or Athletics staff must submit a completed application to Adrienne Howard via [online form](#) by **5:00 PM Wednesday, November 1, 2023**.

Required Elements:

1. Completed application cover sheet
2. Statement (maximum 2 pages, single-spaced in 12 point font) highlighting:
 - a. Philosophy of or approach to fostering excellence in intercollegiate athletics at William & Mary
 - b. Contributions and accomplishments related to student-athletes and/or departmental success
 - c. Evidence of excellence in these areas (e.g. examples of substantial collaboration with students, notable innovation, other forms of recognition, etc.)
3. Current CV (no page limit)

Announcement & Awards

The recipient of the award will be informed in December, and a public announcement will be made during the Spring 2024 semester. Awards will be formally presented to recipients at a ceremony with the President, Provost and Mr. Plumeri in late spring.
