



## Total enrollment (Fall 2015)



### Total enrollment: percent full-time and part-time (Fall 2015)




## Undergraduate enrollment by race/ethnicity (Fall 2015)



## Undergraduate enrollment: percent women (Fall 2015)




## First time full time degree-seeking undergraduate retention rate (Fall 2015)





### Undergraduate admittance and yield (Fall 2015)








### Undergraduate graduation rate

#### Undergraduate graduation rate by gender (Fall 2009 cohort, as of August 31, 2015)




### Bachelors as percentage of total degrees

(Awarded between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015)




#### Doctorates as percentage of total degrees

(Awarded between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015)




## Percentage of total degrees by level

(Awarded between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015)






# Student to faculty ratio (Fall 2015)





## Ratio of FTE students to FTE total staff (Fall 2015)




## Percentage of FTE staff by function (Fall 2015)



## Percentage of full-time faculty (Fall 2015)







## Total revenues per FTE student (FY2015)




## Total expenses per FTE student (FY2015)





### Alumni giving participation rate (FY 2015)




## Undergraduate alumni giving participation rate (FY 2015)



## Graduate alumni giving participation rate (FY 2015)




### Average alumni donor gift (FY 2015)






#### Average undergraduate alumni donor gift (FY 2015)




#### Average graduate alumni donor gift (FY 2015)




#### Average alumni giving to endowment per alumni donor (FY 2015)




#### Total corporate giving (FY 2015)




#### Total foundation giving (FY 2015)



# Total price for students living on campus (2015/2016)






## Price for students after average institutional grant (2014/2015)

## Percent of undergraduates receiving financial aid (2014/2015)





## Percent of undergraduates receiving grant aid (2014/2015)




