



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



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







Chart ENR 7.1 Top 10 Most Popular Undergrad Majors: Fall 2023




Chart ENR 7.2 Top 10 Popular Undergrad Majors VS. Others: Fall 2023







Geographic Distribution of Enrollment by State: Fall 2023







Chart ENR 15.1 Undergraduate STEM Major Enrollment





Chart ENR 15.2 Grad/Professional STEM Major Enrollment
