**The LDOC Fun Act**

An Act of the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary,

WHEREAS, Student Assembly will sponsor an event to engage the community in a positive and informal setting to foster good relationships going into the new semester. The event will take place on May 5th, 2022, which is the last day of classes in the spring semester;

WHEREAS, The last day of classes (LDOC) is a brief period of celebration for students before exams.;

WHEREAS, The purpose of the Student Assembly is to provide opportunities for students with their student activities fee;

WHEREAS, This will be an interactive event for students and for Student Assembly members to get to know their constituents;

WHEREAS, William & Mary can be a stressful institution, and providing a break with fun for students is necessary.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocates \$5,000 from Student Assembly Reserves for the following:
  - a. Dunk Tank ~\$500
  - b. "Pie-ing" Station
    - i. Compostable Plates ~\$100
    - ii. Whip Cream
  - c. Shaved Ice ~\$2,000
  - d. Yard Games ~\$2,300

Stipulates all unused funds remain in Student Assembly Reserves.
