To increase the accessibility of the Student Assembly office in the Sadler Center to SA members

The Increasing Access to SA Office Act

WHEREAS, the expansion of the Sadler Center included the creation of an office for use by Student Assembly leadership and committees for meetings, office hours, and storage;

WHEREAS, there has been a high level of use of this designated space for Student Assembly both during and outside of regular business hours;

WHEREAS, it is important to ensure that this office can be locked to protect the materials/supplies that are stored within the space;

WHEREAS, the current process to access the space is to ask Student Leadership Development or the Sadler Information Desk to unlock the door, which is cumbersome and sometimes inconvenient;

WHEREAS, members of Student Assembly will continue to utilize this space with increasing frequency and card-reader access will increase efficiency and convenience.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary,

1. Allocates \$6,000 from the Student Assembly reserves to fund a card swipe reader for the Student Assembly Office in the Sadler Center.
 - a. Costs include the card reader, installation of the reader, and labor fees (via William & Mary facilities management);
2. Stipulates that all unused funds will return to the Student Assembly Reserves.
