The Pronoun Pin Part 3 Act

An Act of the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by President Mia Tilman ('24), Senator Daniel A. Bess ('24)

Co-sponsored by Senator Sophia L. Tammera ('24), Senator Soleil B. Garnett ('24), Senator Justin E. Bailey ('24)

WHEREAS, Pronoun pins promote a culture of respect and inclusivity by acknowledging and honoring individuals' gender identities. They signal that the campus is a safe and welcoming place for people of all gender identities;

WHEREAS, College campuses are diverse environments with people from various backgrounds and identities. Pronoun pins help create a more inclusive atmosphere by recognizing the existence of gender diversity beyond the binary concept of male and female;

WHEREAS, Wearing pronoun pins makes it easier for people to address others using their correct pronouns, which reduces the likelihood of misgendering. Misgendering can be hurtful and alienating, and pronoun pins help mitigate this issue.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Charges the future sponsors of Senate-funded events and tabling to provide pronoun pins when feasible and reasonable;
2. Allocates \$200 from the Student Assembly Reserves for pins;
 - a. \$40 for 50 She/They Pins
 - b. \$80 for 150 She/Her Pins
 - c. \$40 for 50 Blank Pins
 - d. \$40 for 50 They/Them Pins
3. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
