To facilitate voter awareness in the Williamsburg community

The Let's Vote Act

An Act of the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Senator Spencer Krivo ('26), Senator Matt Swenson ('26), and Senator Hazel Vineet ('25)

Supported by Secretary of Public Affairs Grayson Horner ('26)

WHEREAS, voting is a critical civic duty for an individual living in a democratic society;

WHEREAS, the student body of William & Mary make up a significant portion of voters in Williamsburg;

WHEREAS, the 2023 Virginia general election will occur on Tuesday, November 7th;

WHEREAS, Student Assembly desires to increase student turnout in the fall 2023 elections, because voting is a critical part of student voice in the Williamsburg community, and can yield benefits for the rights and interests of students;

WHEREAS, Virginia holds off-year elections, which generally have lower voter turnout;

WHEREAS, Williamsburg is located in extremely competitive Senate and House of Delegates districts that could decide partisan control of the state legislature;

WHEREAS, several student organizations participate in voter engagement efforts;

WHEREAS, Student Assembly endeavors to be and is required to be non-partisan in all its efforts, and increased student voting regardless of partisanship is beneficial;



WHEREAS, Student Assembly has a stated purpose in getting students involved with local government;

Now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary,

1. Allocates up to \$580 from the Student Assembly Reserves for the purchasing of
 - a. \$80 for 200 full page colored fliers
 - b. \$440 for 1000 half page fliers
 - c. \$60 for 250 2x2 inch stickers

2. Charges the sponsors of the bill to table and help distribute posters and materials
3. Charges the Student Assembly Department of Outreach and Class Senators to advertise the initiative through social media
4. Stipulates that all unused funds be returned to the Student Assembly Reserves.
