To provide a fun campus-wide Fall event

The Fall Frenzy Campus Carving Event

An Act of the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary,

WHEREAS, fostering a sense of community and togetherness among students, faculty, and staff is essential for a thriving campus environment;

WHEREAS, celebrating cultural traditions and seasonal festivities enhances the overall college experience;

WHEREAS, the pumpkin carving event provides an inclusive platform for students from diverse backgrounds to come together and share in the joy of a common creative endeavor;

WHEREAS, encouraging creativity and artistic expression among students promotes personal growth and well-rounded education;

WHEREAS, pumpkin spice brings us all together;

WHEREAS, fostering a sense of belonging and unity on campus contributes to the overall well-being and mental health of our students, creating a more supportive and inclusive learning environment;

WHEREAS, The Fall Frenzy Campus Carving Event will be held tentatively on October 26th, 2023, at 5 p.m. in the Crim Dell Meadow;

WHEREAS, the event will be set up to last approximately 1.5 hours.

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocate up to \$2600 from the Student Assembly Reserves to pay for:

- a. 100 Medium Sized Pumpkins from Pumpkinville in Williamsburg
 - i. (100 for \$6+ delivery fee each) = \$600+
 - b. Carving Tools (75 packs for \$2.09 each) - \$156.75
 - c. 20 x 30 Tarp (1) - \$50.45
 - d. Eco Gloves Plant-Based Compostable Eco-friendly Gloves for Food Prep & Cleaning (2 100 packs for \$8.30 each)
 - e. Furniture Rentals
 - i. Tables - 8 x \$7.50 = \$60
 - ii. Chairs - 32 x \$1.60 = \$51.20
 - iii. Trash Cans - 4 x \$3 = \$12
 - iv. AV rental - \$500
 - 1. This may be free since the event is set to be at Crim Dell Meadow.
 - f. Food and Drink
 - i. Hot Apple Cider from W&M Dining Services on America to Go \$34.99 x 6 gallons = \$210.00
 - ii. "Orchard Treats" (includes apple wedges, caramel sauce, fresh locally sourced cinnamon sugar donuts, maple walnut blondies) from W&M Dining Services on America to Go - \$9.29 x 86 = \$800
2. Charges the Department of Outreach with creating a flyer and promoting the event to students via social media.
 3. Charges the Department of Outreach with creating a flyer to remind students to compost pumpkins afterward and be respectful of the William and Mary community
 4. Charges the Department of Student Life and sponsors of the bill with the following:
 - a. Executing and planning the Event in its entirety
 5. Stipulates that all unused funds go back to the Student Assembly Reserves
