To help RSOs advertise during the Student Organization & Activities Fair,

The Poster Party Part II Act

An Act of the 331st Student Assembly of William & Mary,

Sponsored by Class President Zoe Wang ('26), Senator Matt Swenson ('26)

WHEREAS, multiple RSOs requested funding for tri-folds and other tabling/marketing supplies, to be used during the Student Organization & Activities Fair, in Q1;

WHEREAS, the "Trifold Making Party" streamlines the use of the Student Activities Fee funds by making the same supplies that are requested by multiple organizations available to those organizations; and

WHEREAS, this event will continue to support RSOs in increasing engagement and promoting themselves to students, especially incoming/freshman students;

WHEREAS, the first iteration of the "Trifold Making Party" was held the week of the Student Organization & Activities Fair and was incredibly successful - X organizations made a trifold during the party;

WHEREAS, the second iteration of the "Trifold Making Party" would be held the week of the Spring Semester Student Organization & Activities Fair;

Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Student Assembly of William & Mary:

1. Allocates up to \$1000 from Student Assembly Reserves for;
 - a. \$600 for 52 tri-fold posters
 - b. \$60 for glue, scissors and other crafting supplies
 - c. \$60 for pre-cut adhesive letters
 - i. Muted Color Pack
 - ii. Tropical Color Pack
 - iii. Primary Color Pack
 - d. \$70 for paint markers
 - i. 29 colorful paint markers
 - ii. 12 black paint markers
2. Charges the sponsors of the bill with executing and planning the event;
3. Charges the Secretary of Finance, Class Presidents, and the Department of Outreach with advertising the event;
4. Stipulates that all unused funds will return to the Student Assembly reserves.
