

W&M in Washington

Program Costs

Tuition:

Students enrolled in the W&M in Washington Program pay standard tuition and fees directly to the College for the semester they are enrolled in the Program.

2010-2011 Tuition:

- Virginia Residents: Semester Tuition & Fees = \$6,094.00
- Out-of-State Students: Semester Tuition & Fees = \$16,882.00

Program Fee:

The W&M in Washington program fee is \$500.00. This fee covers costs for programming and events while the students are in Washington. Examples from past semesters include: Orientation week, Family Weekend, group dinners, receptions, special tours, outings to museums or theatres, and activities such as bowling and paintball.

Housing Cost:

The rate for a double room is \$4,000 or \$6,000 for a single room. All students live in either a two-bedroom or three-bedroom apartment at the Buchanan in Arlington, VA – three short Metro stops from Washington. Each spacious apartment is fully furnished and features two bathrooms, plus an equipped kitchen, a dining room, a living room, and a balcony; some also have a den. The Buchanan also provides a 24/7 gym, a billiards room, a coffee lounge, and an outdoor pool. There is a standard \$75 housing application fee and a refundable \$200 security deposit.

Additional Expenses:

The average cost per student varies; however, most students report spending between \$125 - \$175 per week (for 16 weeks) on groceries, metro, and other personal expenses (including toiletries, entertainment and cultural events, social events, and travel beyond DC.)

Financial Aid:

Students currently receiving financial aid can likely increase their aid to match the costs of the Program. All students should work with their financial aid counselors for more specific information.
