- Appropriate shoes

- Personal Printer (No computer lab available)
- Notebooks, pens, etc.
- Required books (check with Professor Wallach)

FOR YOURSELF

- Any prescription medications
- Casual/workout clothes
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Cell phone
- Camera
- Sunglasses
- Umbrella
- W&M Student ID
- Driver's License
- Passport, SS Card (check with your internship for what is required)
- Health Insurance Card
- Portable music player
- First Aid Supplies (Advil, Band-Aids)

FOR THE COMMON AREA

(community vacuum provided)

- Broom, mop
- Extra Lamps
- 60W Light bulbs
- TV/DVD

EXTRAS FOR THE KITCHEN

(only equipped with basics)

- Extra glasses, dishes, pots, specialty knives
- Whisk
- Cutting Board
- Specialty items (Forman, Crock pot, rice cooker)
- Brita
- Cleaning Supplies (dishwasher detergent, etc.)
- Toilet Paper/Paper towels
- Trash bags
