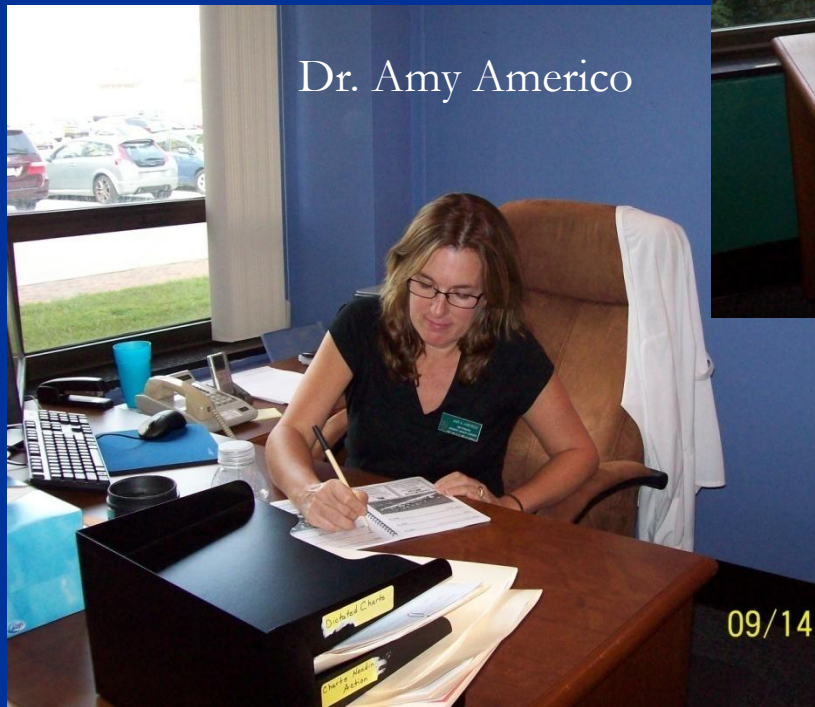

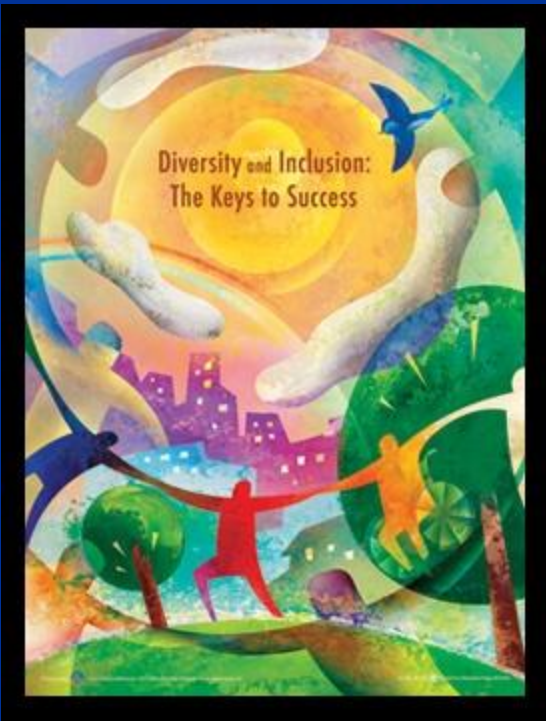
Expanded space!
