

The Leslie Cheek Jr. Scholarship in Art History

History: (Est. 1979) Leslie Cheek was the Chair of the Department in 1937-39, a distinguished critic, and an acclaimed director of the Virginia Museum of Fine Art. When he was at the College, the departments of Art History, Music, and Theater were together. He has left a lasting mark. To honor him, his widow established an endowment in his name.

Applications will be judged on the basis of merit by the Cheek Scholarship Committee, comprising Art History faculty. The scholarships will be announced in early May and apply towards the following academic year.

Eligibility: Students who are declared majors in Art History.
