

## The J. Binford Walford Scholarships for the Study of Architecture

**History:** (est. 1979) The bequest of J. Binford Walford provides an annual fund for scholarships for the study in architectural programs at the College. Usually, the scholarships will be in the form of merit awards intended to provide recognition and encouragement to worthy students. The number and size of awards can vary each year.

The scholarship is renewable only through application and only if the student maintains his or her interest and commitment to architecture. The individual student's continued study of architecture and progress will be reviewed by the student's advisor, usually the Chair, in consultation with the student's professors in architecture.

Applications will be judged on the basis of merit by the Walford Architectural Scholarship Committee comprising a professor of architectural design, a professor of architectural history, and the Chair of the Dept. of Art & Art History. Recommendations by the Committee will then be forwarded to the Dean of the faculty for approval, notification, and the awarding of the scholarship.

**Eligibility:** While it is generally expected that the applicants will be concentrators who apply in their sophomore or junior years, latitude is left for the truly exceptional student, firmly committed to a career in architecture (including entering freshmen) to apply.

### **Include with your Application:**

1. Scholarship Application Form.
2. A statement of your goal in the study in the architecture programs of the Dept. of art & Art History.
3. A statement of your proposed plan of study and proposed use of the award.
4. A statement of prior experience, if applicable, in the field of architecture.
5. Copy of your transcript from Banner Web.
6. Papers or portfolios of projects, as appropriate, that will supplement the application.
7. **Three (3) letters of recommendation** (See: Recommendation Form).
  - Two (2) letters from professors in the Dept. of Art & Art History who can comment on your potential for the study of architecture.
  - One (1) letter from a professor or practicing architect *outside* the Dept.For entering freshmen, such letters should be from appropriate teachers and professional persons.
