Application for the Bachelor's to Master's Accelerated Pathway

Use this form to apply to the Bachelor's to Master's Accelerated Pathway (BMAP) in Computational and Applied Mathematics (CAM) with a concentration in **Operations Research**. Students applying to the BMAP must have completed at least 54 undergraduate credits (including credit for MATH 109, MATH 212, and CSCI 141 or the equivalent), must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0, and must satisfy all requirements in the University's BMAP policy.

Acceptance into the BMAP does not guarantee admission to the Master's degree program. Once you have been accepted into the BMAP, you will complete the BMAP Double Count Form ([sample form](#)) each semester to register for the approved graduate level courses. You must still apply for admission to the M.S. degree program in CAM with a concentration in Operations Research using the official W&M application portal in your senior year to be considered for admission to the M.S. degree in CAM with a concentration in **Operations Research**.

Be sure to **include a copy of your Degree Works** with this form. Students are advised to review the financial aid implications of participation in the BMAP.
