

Application for Admissions Post-Baccalaureate Certificate Program in Classical Studies

The Post-Baccalaureate Program has rolling admissions. The Department welcomes applications **between Dec. 1 and May 1** for admission in the following Fall. You will be notified of the department's decision about one month after we have received your application and all the supporting materials.

Students who wish to apply to the program should follow these instructions:

Send the following items to the address below:

- 1. A completed **application** to the Post-Baccalaureate Program. Fill in the attached application form in type or ink and remember to sign and date it.
- 2. A **personal statement**, not more than two double-spaced pages, explaining your prior experience with Greek, Latin, ancient History and/or Archaeology and also addressing how this program will help you meet your professional and/or personal goals.
- 3. A check or money order for the non-refundable **application fee**, in the amount of \$70.00, payable to "William & Mary".
- 4. If you are a Virginia resident and wish to qualify for the in-state tuition rate, also submit the **form for determining in-state tuition eligibility** available at this address: https://www.wm.edu/offices/deanofstudents/alpha_forms/instatetuition/index.php

Also have the following items sent <u>directly</u> to the address below. Do not have them sent to yourself.

- 1. **Official transcripts** from all colleges or universities you have attended, with the date of actual or expected degree(s) clearly indicated.
- Two letters of recommendation from college or university instructors familiar with your academic
 work. Letters addressing your experience with Latin, ancient Greek and/or other topics in Classical
 Studies would be most welcome.
- 3. If English is not your first language, you may need to establish your English proficiency through **TOEFL or IELTS test scores.** See our "how to apply" page for more information.
