The Table of Actions & Decisions describes the majority of petitions considered in 2008-2009 by the Committee, the Medical Review Committee and the Dean of Students on behalf of the Committee. There was an overall decrease of 142 actions from 2007-2008 to the 2008-2009 total of 967 petitions. Student requests for exceptions for late adds, drops, and underloads had the greatest decreases from the previous two semesters. Of the remaining categories, requests for medical withdrawals (both active and retroactive) from a single class or semester also declined.

The Table of 2008-2009 Academic Year Academic Standing reports academic continuance decisions made by the Committee. A larger number than usual of students on probation attended summer session in 2009 to meet their continuance standards. This accounts for much of the difference between the number of students who were put on probation or continuing probation in May and the numbers actively on probation in Fall semester 2009.
