Re: Proposed increase in Elective Credits Counted Towards Graduation from Military Science

On May 9, 2007, the Educational Policy Committee considered a Military Science proposal to increase the number of credits granted to ROTC cadets enrolled in Military Science courses from 8 to 20 and to increase the number of Military Science credits counted toward graduation from 6 to 12.

The committee voted and did not approve this request and instead voted to recommend that MLSC 101, 102, 201, and 202 carry one credit each and that MLSC 301, 302, 401, and 402 carry 2 credits each. Cadets could earn a total of 12 Military Science credits, and up to 8 of those credits could count toward the graduation requirements.

The EPC requests the Faculty approve this recommendation.
