Resolution on the Governance of the St. Andrew's—William and Mary Joint Degree Program

Faculty of Arts and Sciences Meeting February 2, 2010

The Faculty Affairs Committee (FAC) requests adoption of the following resolution regarding the governance of the St. Andrew's—William and Mary Joint Degree Program:

"Whereas the academic experiences, in Williamsburg, of the students in the St. Andrew's-William and Mary Joint Degree Program will for now be centered in the Faculty of Arts and Sciences;

Whereas the separate admission, tuition and fee, and academic offering needs of the joint program require novel governance structures;

The Faculty of Arts & Sciences resolves that (a) the Joint Degree Council should consist of representatives of appropriate Arts and Sciences units and the Reves Center as well as the St. Andrew's counterparts; (b) the Joint Degree Council will, for now, provide a report, through FAC, to the Faculty of Arts and Sciences annually; (c) tuition and fee revenues from the Joint Degree Program be set appropriately to cover the full cost of the Program to Arts & Sciences; and (d) adequate provisions be made to accommodate additional pressures on departments and to fully exploit the new opportunities promised by the Program, i.e., additional FTEs and scholarships as well as support for travel, research, and teaching exchanges."
