The EPC has approved a proposal from Academic Advising that A&S adopt a policy requiring that to complete a minor at W&M, a student must complete at least nine of the required credits in residence.

The proposed new catalog copy would read: "No degree will be granted by the College until the applicant has completed a minimum of 60 credit hours in residence at the College. This period must include the last two full-time semesters in which credits counted toward the degree are earned. A minimum of 15 credit hours in the major and 9 credit hours in the minor must be taken in residence at the College." (The part that is underlined indicates the proposed addition.)
