## **DRAFT**

The Faculty of Arts & Sciences resolves that Arts & Sciences components of the St. Andrew's-William and Mary Joint Degree Program, hereafter referred to as the Joint Degree Program, shall be administered under the following terms:

- 1. The Arts & Sciences components of the Joint Degree Program at the College of William and Mary are governed by the Faculty of Arts & Sciences in collaboration with St. Andrew's University through the Joint Degree Council.
- 2. No major changes in the Arts & Sciences components of the Joint Degree Program, such as continuation or renewal of Arts & Sciences participation in the Joint Degree Program, or addition of Arts & Sciences degree tracks within the program, shall be made without the approval of the Faculty of Arts & Sciences.
- 3. The Arts & Sciences components of the Joint Degree Program shall be governed by an Arts & Sciences St. Andrew's Program Committee whose members shall be as follows:
  - a. The degree track advisors in each of the departments and programs participating in the Joint Degree Program. At the time of this memo, these are Economics, History, and International Relations.
  - b. The Assistant Dean for St. Andrew's in the Arts & Sciences Dean's office who will serve as Chair.
  - c. Two other tenured faculty members from departments or programs not involved in the Joint Degree Program, appointed by the Faculty Affairs Committee (FAC), with a preference for the chair of Study Abroad Committee or another of its members.
  - d. The contact dean in the Arts & Sciences Dean's office who is the liaison for international studies. At the time of this memo, this is the Dean for Educational Policy.
  - e. A representative of Academic Advising.
  - f. The Reves Center Director and the Registrar, or their designees, and representatives from Student Affairs and Admissions, may attend the meeting as needed but shall not vote.
- 4. The Arts & Sciences St. Andrew's Program Committee shall serve as liaison for Arts & Sciences with the Joint Degree Council.
- 5. The Arts & Sciences Program Committee shall keep the Joint Degree Council informed of its communications with counterparts at St. Andrew's as academic issues are addressed.
- 6. Proposed new undergraduate degree tracks and courses as well as major curricular changes within Arts & Sciences in the Joint Degree Program must be brought by the Arts & Sciences St. Andrew's Program Committee to the Educational Policy Committee (EPC) for consideration before being submitted to the Faculty of Arts & Sciences. Proposed new graduate degree tracks and graduate courses within Arts & Sciences in the Joint Degree Program must be brought by the Arts & Sciences St. Andrew's Program Committee to the Committee on Graduate Studies (COGS) for consideration before being submitted to the Faculty of Arts & Sciences.
- The Arts & Sciences St. Andrew's Program Committee shall make an annual report on its
  activities during the previous academic year to FAC and the Faculty of Arts & Sciences in
  September.
- 8. Proposed changes in these terms shall be discussed by FAC and brought to the Faculty for discussion and vote.
