- 1. The meeting started at 3:30 and the minutes of Dec. 2, 2015 were approved with two amendments Jack Zhang's name was listed twice and in bullet 4, the "CLA will receive the first COLL 150 and 200 assessment reports...", the 150 was changed to 100.
- 2. The courses listed in Appendix A were given CSI domain designations.
- 3. The courses listed in Appendix B were given CSI domain designations and asked to return to EPC if the history department wants them to have ALV designations.
- 4. The courses listed in Appendix C were given ALV domain designations. It was agreed to discuss at a later date whether to assign blanket domain designations to topics courses.
- 5. The courses listed in Appendix D were given ALV domain designations. These are courses offered this semester.
- 6. The courses listed in Appendix E were given CSI domain designations. These are courses offered this semester.
- 7. The courses BIOL230/GEOL330/MSCI330 as well as KINE 460 were all given NQR domain designations.
- 8. The proposal for ART 440-03 for COLL200 ALV \rightarrow CSI&NQR was rejected. The proposal for ART 440-04 for COLL200 ALV \rightarrow CSI&NQR was approved.
- 9. The proposal for MUSC 363 COLL200 ALV → CSI was approved. The proposal for GOVT 390 Bosnia Project for COLL300 designation was approved with the suggestion that the syllabus should specify that credit for the course could only be obtained if the student actually goes on the trip to Sarajevo.
- 10. The LING 480 proposal for COLL300 was tabled to await Jack Martin's wisdom at the next meeting.
- 11. The following were all approved: St Andrews Programme: Changing course options for the English major AMES312, Permanent number for already approved COLL200 topics course

CRWR368-369, Removing ACTV and GER6 designation

FREN303, CSI domain designation for a section of a topic course "the French Rev."

GOVT307, ACTV designation

AMES: adding course options to the East Asian track of the AMES major

HIST306, permanent number for a topics course

KINES, Adding course option to major requirements

A proposal from SPCH410 was deemed unnecessary.

- 12. FREN 299,300,302 were approved as 4 credit courses, and COLL300 designation will be discussed at the next meeting
- 13. FREN 361,385 were approved for ALV designation, FREN 362,363 were approved for CSI designation.
- 14. PHYS201 was approved for COLL200 NQR → CSI, and for an increase from 3 to 4 credits.
