1. The minutes of 3/22/2016 were approved.

2. Pass/Fail

We voted to change catalogue language (see below) to make it clear that you cannot count any pass-fail courses toward the major. Motion passed.

*Courses taken on a Pass/Fail basis may not be used to satisfy general education (GER or COLL), proficiency, minor or major requirements, **including electives that are counted toward major or minor requirements.***

3. Study away courses: should we go ahead and approve/disapprove these in principle and figure out the details of how students will be given credit later? We agreed that giving the COLL 300 credit makes sense in principle – the challenge is how to actually implement this plan.
