EPC Minutes for 4/26/2016

1. Approval of 4/22 minutes

2. Brief Announcements (which were not so brief)

- The FLP issue will take a while, and will thus be deferred to the fall.
- CLA and EPC – Bill had several talks with Gene Tracy. EPC is very unhappy. After **much** discussion, a motion was approved asking Bill to write a memo, check it with the Committee and then send it to the CLA
- It was agreed that Jack's list does not need to go to the faculty, but should be put on the EPC website as an FAQ. It was also agreed to add to Jack's list the statement that topics courses can get domain designations only if they are in a single domain.
- Denise sent around a document concerning language in the syllabus for C100 and C200. It was approved to recommend that this language be included in course syllabi.
- There was discussion as to whether the online course statement should go to the FAS, perhaps not for a vote but for information. Such a decision was deferred to the fall.
