### Pass/Fail options for Fall 2020

The committee discussed whether to add an addendum to the P/F policy to restrict the option to students without Honor Code sanctions. After discussion, including the input of the Dean of Students, it was decided not to formally modify the P/F policy, but rather to recommend the following guidance for the Honor Council during Fall, 2020:

In light of the increased eligibility and extended deadline for students to select a course to be graded Pass/Fail during the Fall 2020 semester, and in order that students subject to grading sanctions by the Honor Council not take advantage of the Pass/Fail option so as to mitigate those sanctions, the Educational Policy Committee recommends that the Honor Council consider attaching a no-Pass/Fail clause to students' classes that are subject to such grading sanctions. EPC recommends that the no-P/F clause restrict a student's eligibility to switch a course that is subject to grading sanctions from letter grade to P/F, unless the student selected the P/F option prior to the incident identified as an Honor Code violation. Any such restrictions imposed by the Honor Council must be forwarded to the Registrar.
