3. Other proposals

GIS - 201 and 201L - Introduction to Geographic Information Systems / Introduction to Geographic Information (Lab Section) Delinking

Discussion about whether the contact hours and assignments for the course merit 3 or 4 credits. There is not a justification for this delinking with the current contact hours. Consensus in discussion that a 3-credit course with a 0-credit lab may be most appropriate and consistent with other lecture/lab configured courses.

Approved as a 3-credit course with 0 credit lab. Course is not approved to be delinked.

HIST - 201 - History Lab New course

Discussion on terminology of "lab" and how is this different from a 1-credit independent study. A course proposal would be helpful to EPC in this situation.

Tabled. Wustholz will return to faculty member to ask for additional information.

History - Africana Studies Curriculum change

Discussion about whether this course content focuses on a written system, or a language. Course is already approved at department level to fulfill the Africana Studies requirement.

Approved with addendum to request change to proposal to clarify how this fits the departmental requirement. Suggest to add to Item 3 on Africana Studies Language Requirement "...Africana Studies courses on African Languages **or Cultural History**...".
