Discussion of internship component, additional information needed from instructor about delinking. Tabled for now.

RELG - 346 - Religion & Politics in the United States, COLL 350, Delinking
Approved.

KINE - TBD - Measurement and Accountability: Who is responsible for the public's health? COLL 300, Delinking

Concerns raised in previous meeting about COLL 300 coverage. Instructor revised the proposal. Approved, with the understanding that the EPC chair will ask instructor for additional language related to COLL 300.

ENGL - 465 - 21st-Century Museum Studies: Washington DC, COLL 300, Delinking

Discussion of choice of speakers, lived experience component, and possible COLL 350 status. Approved.

UREG Department - Credit Hour Residency Requirement Policy

Clarification of previous proposal. Approved.

UREG Department - Transfer Credit - Studying Away from the University after Matriculation Policy

Clarification of initial proposal, Committee on Degrees agreed with concerns raised in EPC that prior language was too broad. Revised proposal approved.
