- 1. Discussed a draft of Kate Conley's memo that will serve as an introduction to the A&S Faculty Manual update
- 2. Had a brief discussion of progress on the manual:

  - Since there are no changes to policies in the manual, the revision need not go to a vote of FAS
  - Martin will review the new portion and then send it on to FAC
- 3. Discussed strategy for filling vacancies on College committees for 2018-19. (There are only 19.) The suggested strategies are:
  - Go to CCPD to ask chairs to sign up nominations from their departments
  - Put a volunteer form on the Digest
  - Get a list of faculty returning from leave (from Kathy Morgan)
  - Reminder to recommend faculty who are lesser known, just tenured, have difficult names, etc.
- 4. The Nominations & Elections Committee has been shrunk from 9 to 6 members. FAC needs to present a motion at the October meeting to amend the A&S by-laws (Article V, Section 1.1).
- 5. Cathy announced that Marc Sher has agreed to join the COLL 199 sub-committee as co-chair with Hannah Rosen.
- 6. Even though he is teaching at the time of our meetings, Greg Smith will continue with FAC this semester and be consulted by e-mail.
- 7. FAC decided to cancel its Sept. 18<sup>th</sup> meeting in order to attend Tia Brown McNair's Inclusion Workshop that day.
