Minutes of the Faculty Affairs Committee, April 13, 2021

The meeting was held on Zoom videoconference and began at 2 p.m.

- 1. Approved minutes from the April 5 FAC meeting.
- 2. Updates from Maria
  - a. Maria had a good meeting with the Council of Chairs & Program Directors last week.
  - b. Discussed how to talk in public about resignations from Committee on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (CDEI).
  - c. Discussed some personnel matters
- 3. Plans for April and May FAS meetings
  - a. Proposal for a Department of Data Science
    - i. Discussed whether tabling or referring to a committee could be appropriate at April FAS meeting. Maria noted that tabling is only available if another urgent matter comes up.
    - ii. Compared Data Science proposal to the formation of the Department of Applied Science: whether faculty voted then (they did), who made the motion (the motion came from two committees according to May 2, 1995 FAS meeting minutes).
  - b. Planning ahead for May meeting
    - i. Retirement narratives
    - ii. CDEI report
    - iii. Maria asked that we give time to students proposing a data literacy requirement.
    - iv. Plan to vote on edited version of Dean's memo on tenure, promotion, and interim review
- 4. FAC appointed committees
  - a. Current membership of each committee is not clear.
  - b. Josh assigned an FAC member to each committee. Each of us should contact the chair of assigned committees and figure out who is participating.
- 5. Discussed issues with students reporting concerns about faculty
- 6. Dean's memo about promotion to senior lecturer
  - a. Current practice evidently does not include chairs and program directors giving a non-budget rationale as to how an NTE faculty member meets curricular needs better than a TE faculty member.
  - b. Josh suggested revising the Dean's memo to drop that part. Peter noted that requirement is part of the faculty-approved NTE personnel policy, which would need to be revised in addition to the memo.
- 7. Role of FAC in the re-start of Strategic Planning. Brief discussion that will be continued at the next FAC meeting.
