- 1) We approved the minutes for April 25, 2023

We wondered if some of the recommendations should be passed on to departments and programs. We decided we would go over the Guidelines again with FAS faculty, and then wait until Fall for any kind of vote. The Dean expressed her desire for more consistent practices and policies across A&S with respect to merit, tenure and promotion, hiring, and selecting chairs, for example. Our goal with the Merit Guidelines is to make headway with a template of sorts for merit across departments and programs.
- 5) Dean's Updates:
 - a. TFF is going ahead. A&S Senior Lecturers will be set at Associate or Full, and will be announced shortly. The Dean team will meet with new Teaching or Research Faculty Framework committee in the fall.
- 6) JC's survey went out for volunteers to Appointed Committees. Over 60 faculty responded. Many said "Put me where you need me." We have information on 6 committees that need spots filled. There will be more.
