

**Study Abroad Committee**  
**Minutes April 3, Colony Room, UC**

Minutes from the March 27 meeting were approved.

In response to a query from a faculty member, the committee discussed the issue of competition between William and Mary programs and non-William and Mary programs. The questions posed were: What role does the Reves Center play in supporting William and Mary programs over non-William and Mary programs? What role does the committee play? Are there ways to encourage students to select William and Mary programs, particularly when the competing programs are in the same country or city? Are there ways to discourage students from selecting non-William and Mary programs.? No definitive decisions were reached on this issue. The committee did, however, agree to ask the Reves Center what measures are routinely used by the staff to direct students in their program choices.
