ITEM 1:

John and Kelly Charles appeared to discuss the Goa Program in which some teaching and directorial re-arrangements need to be made.

The new arrangement is that John will serve as director and teach one course and that Kelly will teach a 1-credit Yoga course and will identify someone in Goa to teach such a course next summer. The students will take 7-8 credits.

The SAC committee APPROVED this arrangement.

ITEM 2:

New guidelines are being prepared by Reves for study abroad programs. Input by the SAC is sought and the responsibility of SAC with respect to Reves will be discussed at the next meeting.

There was a discussion of whether Prof. Fisher's position on the Committee is voting or non-voting; clarification will be sought via Terry Meyers and the FAC.

ITEM 3:

Prof. Campbell suggested that future discussion is needed concerning how local courses on study abroad programs are to be decided. All seemed to agree that syllabi and/or other documentation are needed to justify granting W&M credit for such courses.

ITEM 4:

Discussion of the Prague Program and of the question of how to affiliate it with a Czech university and which one: should the program move from CERGE-EI University to Charles University?

The possibility of two separate Prague programs was considered: one in A&S generally, one in Economics and/or Business.

The committee VOTED to recommend affiliation with Charles University as soon as possible.
