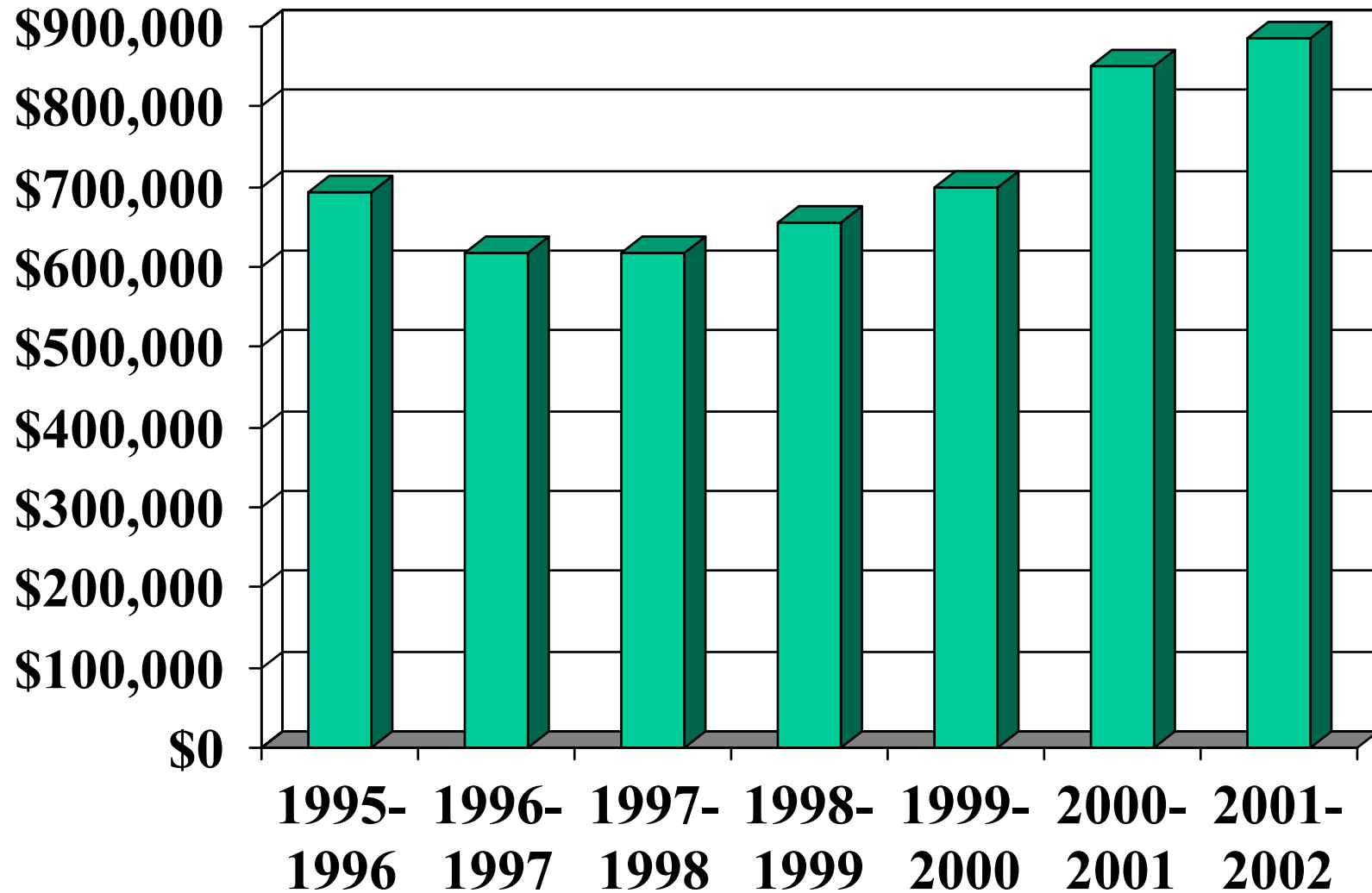


Faculty Research Budget, 1995-2002



Research Committee Procedures

a) area subcommittee stage

- rank FRA proposals with 6 or more service years
- declare a fundable/unfundable cutoff line
- rank all SRG proposals on qualitative grounds
- declare a fundable/unfundable cutoff line

b) committee chair's stage

- normalize subcommittee rankings

c) committee stage

- reach consensus on FRA recommendations

[special consideration to first time FRA applicants]

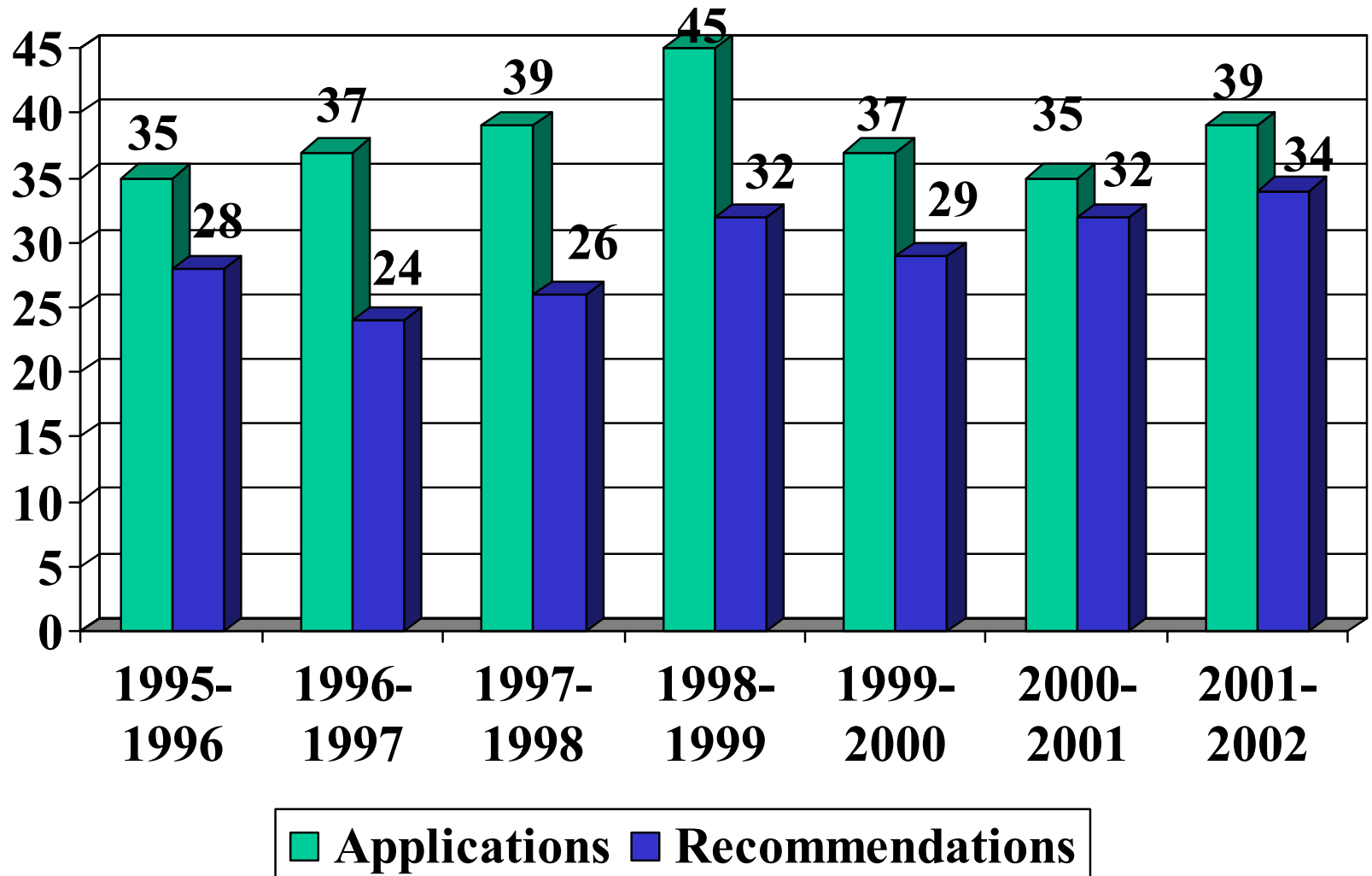
- calculate how many SRGS can thus be funded
- reach consensus on SRG recommendation

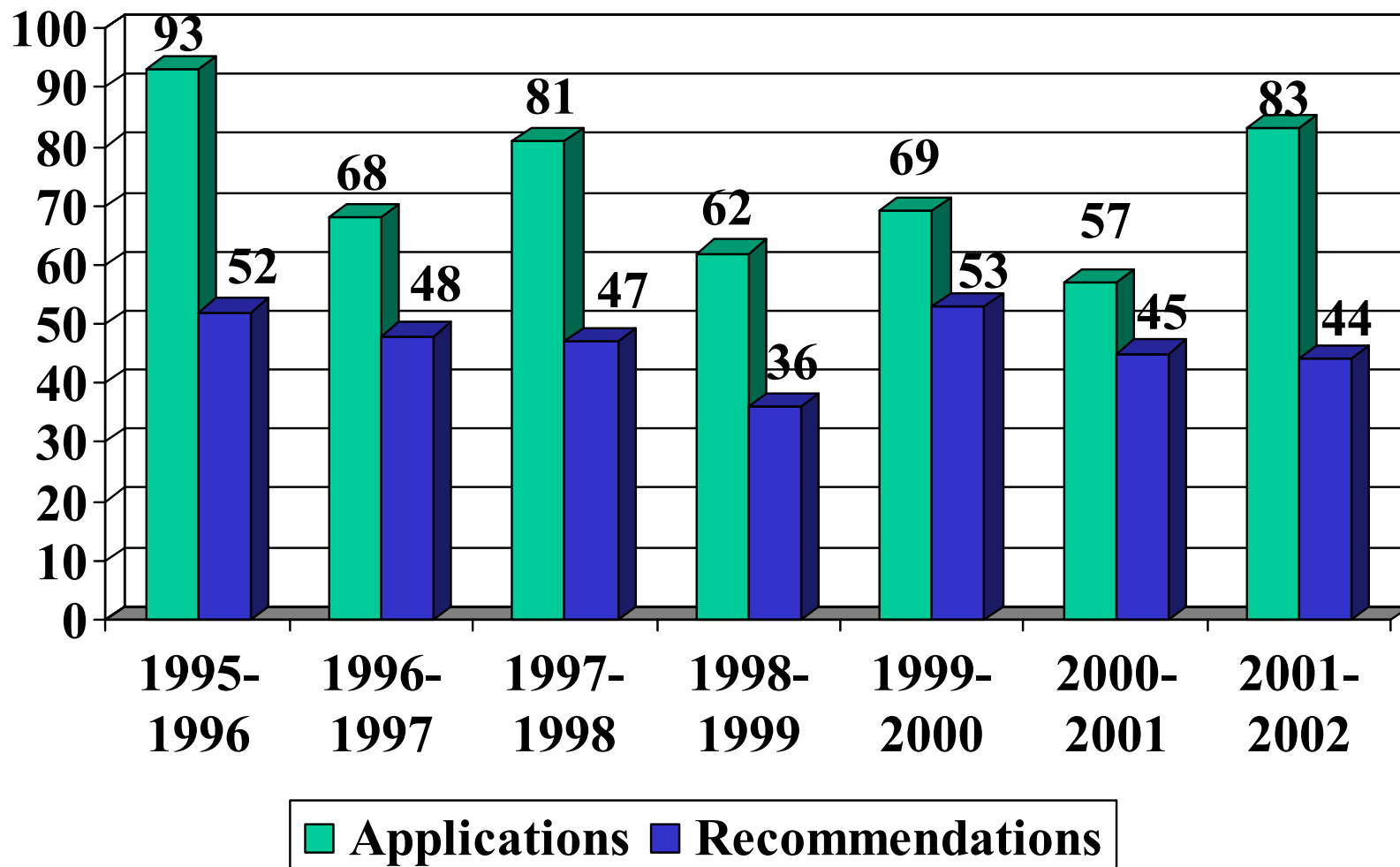

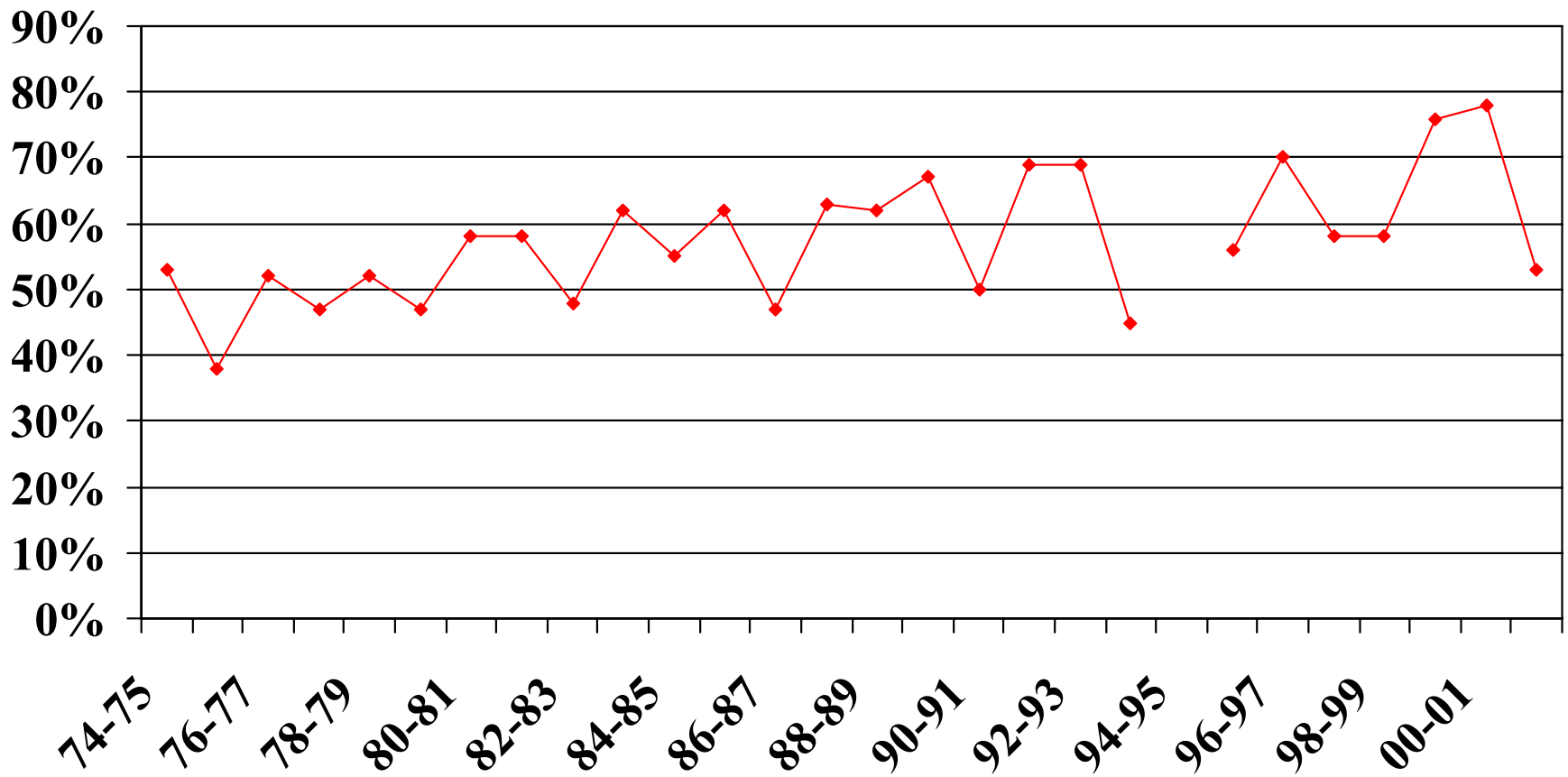

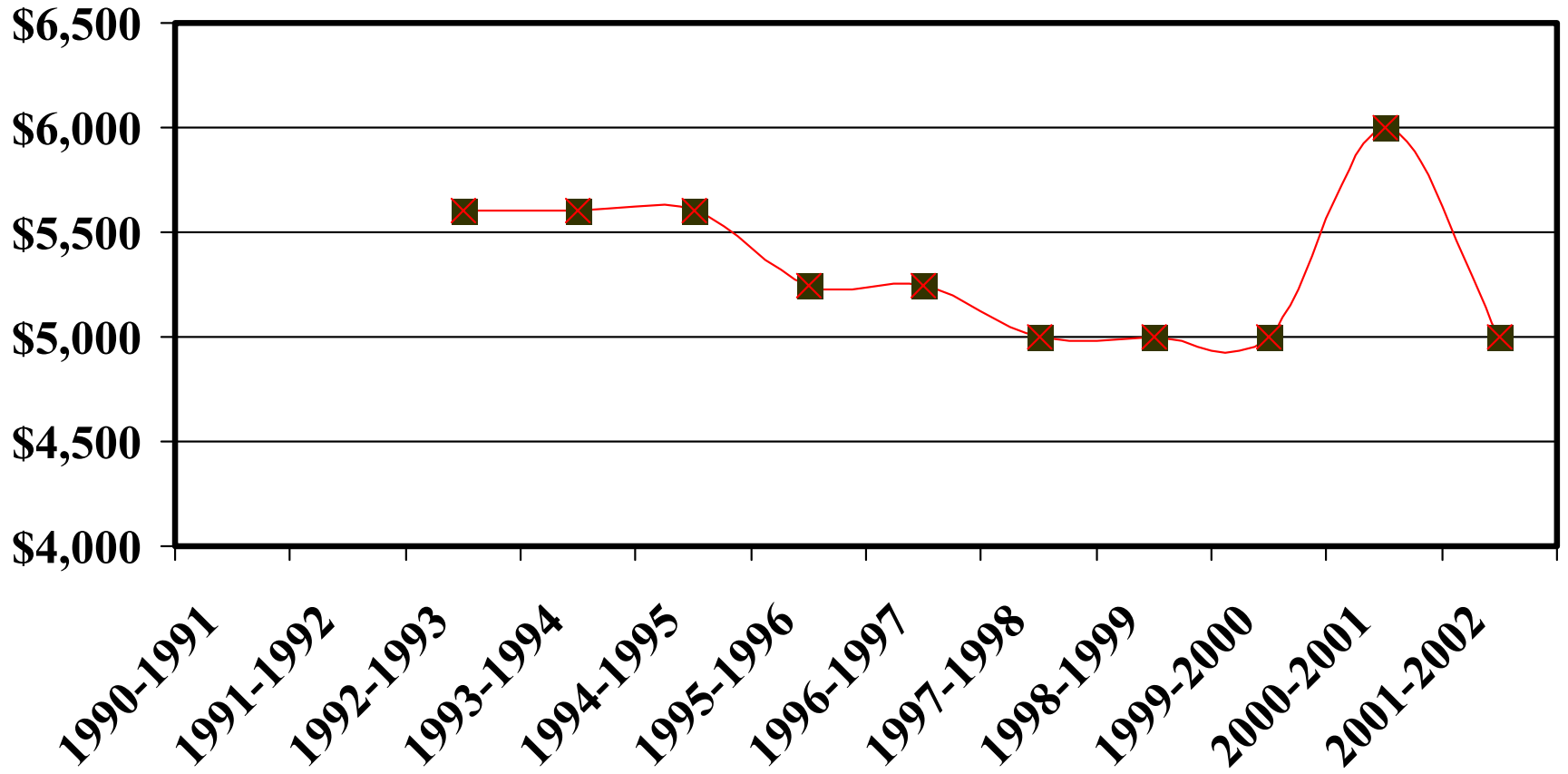


Summer Grant Success Rate, 1974-2002*

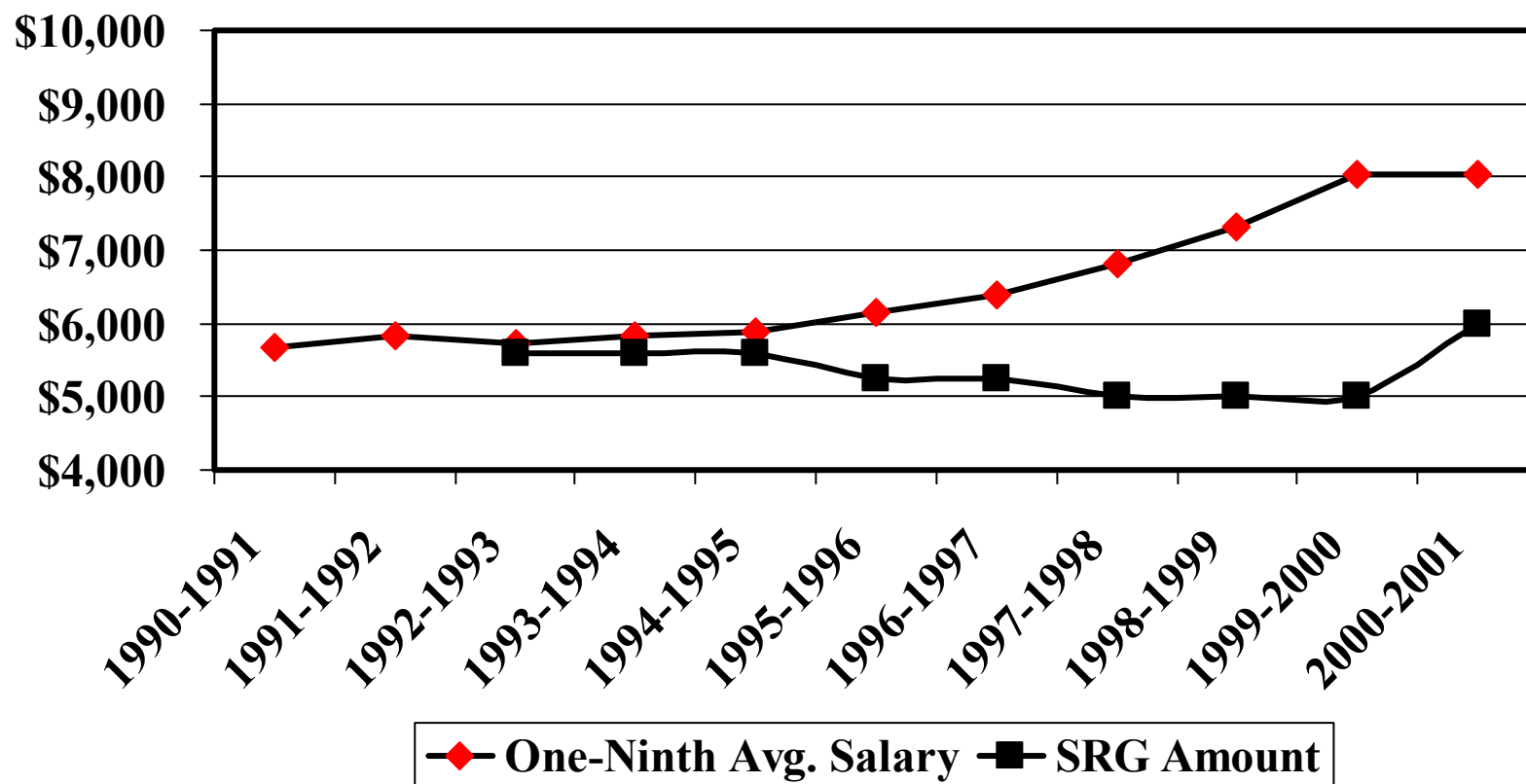


SRG Amount
