Restoration	Jobs: waste management, environmental remediation technician, environmental consultant, hydrologist  Description: restore natural habitats for wildlife and recreational use, remove and prevent pollution in water sources and soil, assist in urban planning from environmentally conscious perspective
Land Use	Jobs: Land management and planning, zoning technician, construction management, urban planner, civil/environmental engineer  Description: manage urban and industrial planning, construction, and zoning

- Most positions require previous work in a related field
