Employers

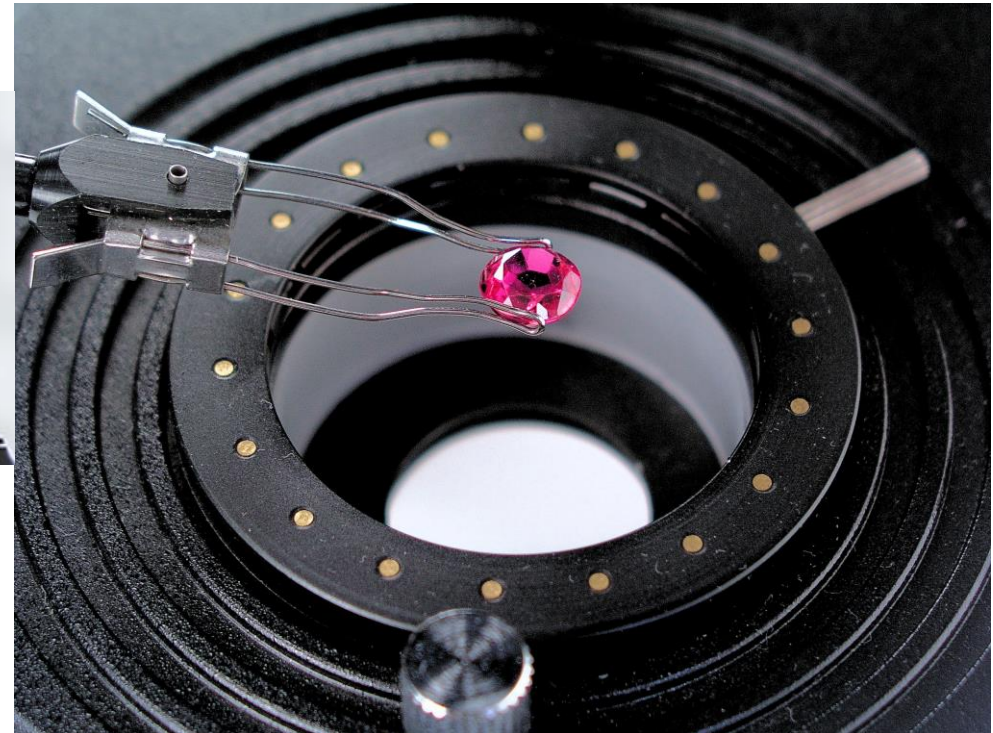
- gemstone buyers, lab researcher and grader, appraisers, jewelry designers, auction houses, pawn shops and museums.
